finished measurements

BUST: 34 (38, 42)"

86 (97, 108)cm

yarn

4 (5, 5) skeins Elsebeth Lavold Silky Wool
(65% wool, 35% silk) 175m/50g

needles

size US 6 (4mm)

size US (3.25mm) 40" circular

size US (3.25mm) dpns

notions

darning needle

gauge

24sts x 32 rows = 4" (10 cm)

in stockinette st

notes

- Please see Wave patterns below – the right and left front pieces of the 38" bust size begin at the midpoint of the wave pattern.

stitch guide

'WAVE PATTERN A'

For all back pieces, 34" & 42" bust, right and left fronts

R1: k

R2: p

R3: k1, *(k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times*, repeat from * to * until 1 st remains, k1

R4: k

'WAVE PATTERN B'

For 38" bust, right and left fronts

R1: k

R2: p

R3: k1, (yo, k1) 3 times, *(k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times*, repeat from * to * until 1 st remains, k1

R4: k

back

CO 110 (128, 146) sts

Work rows 1 to 4 of 'Wave Pattern A' 8 times (32 rows completed). Change to stockinette st.

Work 2 rows of stockinette st, ending with a WS row.

Decrease row – k1, k2tog, k6, *k2tog, k7* 10 (12, 14) times, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k1. 97 (113, 129) sts remain.

Waist Shaping

Next RS row: dec 1 st at each end of this row. Dec every 4th row 3 (2, 1) more times, and then every 2nd row 0 (3, 6) times. 89 (101, 113) sts remain. Work even until piece measures 7 ½ (7 ¾, 8)" from lowest point on cast on edge, ending with a WS row.

Bust Shaping

Next RS row: inc 1 st at each end of the row. Inc every 8th row 5 (5, 5) more times. Work even until piece measures 13 ½ (14 ¼, 14 ¾)" from lowest point on CO edge. 101 (113, 125) sts

Armhole shaping

BO 3 at beginning of next 2 rows. BO 2 at beginning of foll 2 rows. Dec armhole every row 5 (5, 6) times. Work even until armhole measures 6 ½ (7, 7 ½)" ending with a RS row.

Neck Shaping

Next row: p22 (22, 23), join new yarn, BO center 37 (41, 45) sts, purl to end of row. Working both sides at the same time, dec neck on next 2 RS rows.

Shoulder Shaping

AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures 6 ¾ (7 ¼, 7 ¾)", BO 10 (12, 14) sts on outer edges of armholes. Then BO 10 (12, 13) rem sts.

right front

Cast on 56 (65, 74) sts

*Use Wave Pattern B for 38" size

Work rows 1 to 4 of 'Wave Pattern A(B, A)' 8 times (32 rows completed). Change to stockinette st. Work 2 rows of St st, ending with a WS row

Decrease row – k1, k2tog, k6, *k2tog, k7* 4 (5, 6) times, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k1. 49 (57, 65) sts remain.

Waist Shaping

Next RS row: dec 1 st at end of the row. Dec every 4th row 3 (2, 1) more times, and then every 2nd row 0 (3, 6) times. 45 (51, 57) sts remain. Work even until piece measures 7 ½ (7 ¾, 8)" from lowest point on CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Bust Shaping

Next RS row: inc 1 st at end of the row. Inc every 8th row 5 (5, 5) more times. Work even until piece measures 13 ½ (14 ¼, 14 ¾)" from lowest point on cast on edge.

Neck Shaping

AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 9 ½ (10, 10 ½)", on RS row, BO 3 and dec for neck shaping. Decrease neck edge every 4th row 17 (19, 21) more times.

Armhole shaping

BO 3 at beginning of next WS rows. BO 2 at beginning of foll WS rows. Dec armhole every row 5 (5, 6) times. Work even until armhole measures 6 ½ (7, 7 ½)" ending with a RS row.

Shoulder Shaping

AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures 6 ¾ (7 ¼, 7 ¾)", on the next WS row BO 10 (12, 14) sts. Next Row (RS): BO 10 (12, 13) rem sts.

left front

Cast on 56 (65, 74) sts

*Use Wave Pattern B for 38" size

Work rows 1 to 4 of 'Wave Pattern A(B, A)' 8 times (32 rows completed). Change to stockinette st.

Work 2 rows of stockinette st, ending with a WS row

Decrease row – k1, k2tog, k6, *k2tog, k7* 4 (5, 6) times, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k1. 49 (57, 65) sts remain.

Waist Shaping

Next RS row: dec 1 st at beginning of the row. Dec every 4th row 3 (2, 1) more times, and then every 2nd row 0 (3, 6) times. 45 (51, 57) sts remain.

Work even until piece measures 7 ½ (7 ¾, 8)" from lowest point on cast on edge, ending with a WS row.

Bust Shaping

Next RS row: inc 1 st at beginning of the row. Inc every 8th row 5 (5, 5) more times. Work even until piece measures 13 ½ (14 ¼, 14 ¾)" from lowest point on cast on edge.

Neck Shaping

AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 9 ½ (10, 10 ½)", on WS row, BO 3 and dec for neck shaping.

Decrease neck edge every 4th row 17 (19, 21) more times.

Armhole shaping

BO 3 at beginning of next RS rows

BO 2 at beginning of following RS rows

Dec armhole every row 5 (5, 6) times.

Work even until armhole measures 6 ½ (7, 7 ½)", ending with a WS row.

Shoulder Shaping

AT THE SAME TIME, when armhole measures 6 ¾ (7 ¼, 7 ¾)", on the next RS row BO 10 (12, 14) sts. Next row (WS): Then BO 10 (12, 13) rem sts.

cap sleeves (make 2)

Cast on 46 (50, 56) sts

Beginning with a RS row, work in stockinette for 2 (4, 4) rows, ending with a WS row.

Dec each end of the next row, and every 4th row 4 (5, 6) more times, then dec every RS row 6 (5, 5) times.

Sleeve Cap Shaping

BO 3 (4, 5) sts at beginning of next 2 rows

BO remaining sts.

finishing

Block all pieces to measurements. Sew shoulder seams. Set in cap sleeves and sew in place.

Armhole Finishing

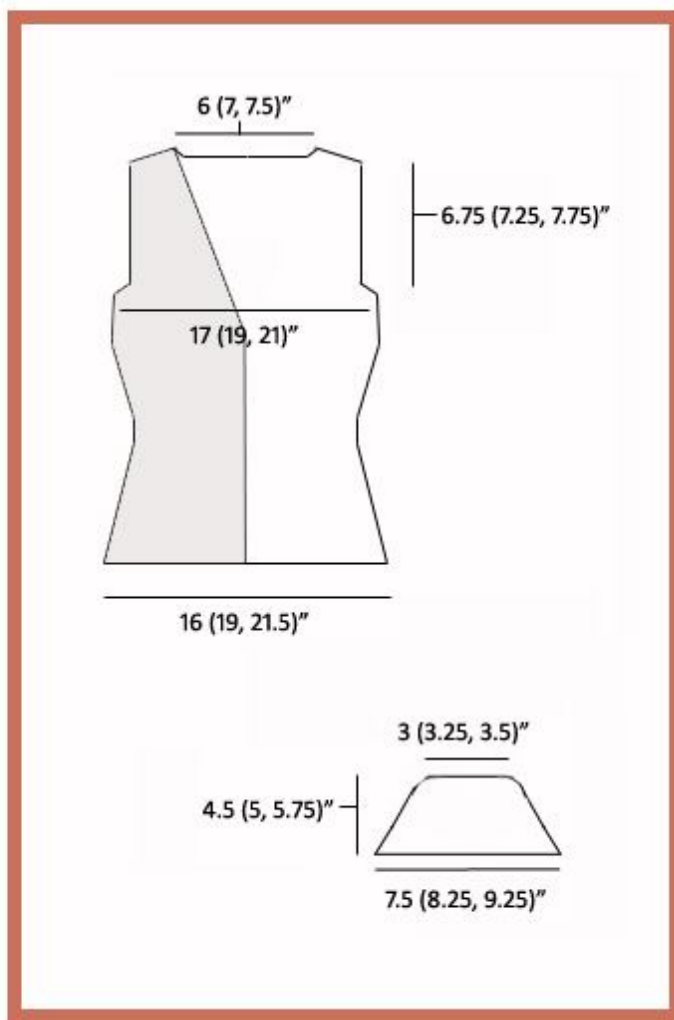
With 3.25mm circular needle, pick up 74 (80, 90) sts evenly around armhole. Work i-cord bind off on all sts.

Front & Neck Finishing

With 3.25mm circular needle, pick up 163 (171, 179) sts from left front, 51 (53, 55) sts across back neck, and 163 (171, 179) from right front.

I-Cord tie

With 3.25mm dpn, pick up 4 sts from outer edge of i-cord BO trim at beginning of neck dec. Work 24" i-cord, BO. Repeat on other front.
